Position Summary:

This position will be accountable for designing, building, and testing industrial electrical control and automation systems. This is a hands-on position, requiring the individual to work directly with engineering and manufacturing teams.

Principle Duties / Responsibilities:

- Acts as the PLC programming and hardware specialist.
- Supports all engineering projects and new plant design.
- Trouble shoot as required to ensure continuous running of the equipment.
- Develop, design and implement best practices for process controls and instrumentation.
- Start up and commissioning.
- Communicate with other employees and management respectfully to complete work tasks.
- Adhere to company policies, Good Manufacturing Practices, SQF and safe food procedures.
- Ability to work additional hours if needed.
- Demonstrate excellent attendance and punctuality.
- Other tasks or duties as assigned by management.

Competencies and Skills:

- Hands on experience with programming and hardware including but limited to PLCc, HMI programming, Modicon, Wonderware, and/or Alen Bradley Controls.
- Working knowledge of electrical schematics, electrical distribution, communication networks, wiring diagrams and panel outlets.
- Working knowledge of the electrical code.
- Understanding of ARC Flash restrictions.

Position Qualifications:

- Must be at least 18 years of age
- Must have an Associate's Degree or equivalent work experience.
- Minimum 4 years of working experience with instrumentation and controls in an industrial plant or process manufacturing setting.
- Ability to work with minimal supervision.
- Ability to operate various types of power lifts
- Must be able to lift, push and pull up to 50lbs.
- Ability to climb ladders and perform work in varying heights.
- Ability to walk, bend, reach, and twist regularly throughout an 8-hour shift.
- Ability to work in an environment with extreme warm temperatures



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- Manual dexterity of hands and fingers to handle or feel objects, tools and controls.
- Must be able to comply with Good Manufacturing Practices, Food Safety, and SQF regulatory program requirements.
- Must be able to follow written and/or oral procedures and instructions given by management.
- Must be able to be on time, and adhere to attendance policies.
- Previous experience in a food manufacturing environment is a plus.
